Paul Emsley

Deon has published fifteen novels and two short story collections. His books have been translated into 28 languages in more than 40 countries world-wide. He has written several series for television, and six screenplays for feature films.

Accolades for his books include Le Grand Prix de Littérature Policière (2003) and Le prix Mystère de la critique (2004) from France, the Deutsche Krimi Preis (2006, 2009), the Swedish Martin Beck Award (2010, 2021), the ATKV Prose Prize (2000, 2003, and 2004), the ATKV Suspense Fiction Prize (2008, 2009, 2011, 2014, 2019), the M-Net Award for Most Filmic Novel (2009, 2012), and the Barry Award for Best Thriller in the USA (2010).

He was knighted by France in 2021 as Chevalier des Arts et des Lettres.

He lives in Stellenbosch with his wife Marianne, and is passionate about South Africa, Mozart, mountain biking, cooking, photography, golf, as well as the Free State Cheetahs and Springbok rugby.

Paul Emsley is a British-born artist who worked as an illustrator and creative director before fulfilling a teaching position at Stellenbosch University's Department of Creative Arts. He later moved back to England to pursue a full-time career as an independent artist with a keen eye for the close observation of the subject amidst the interplay of light and shade. He is, amongst his extensive accomplishments also known for having been commissioned for a portrait study of Catherine, Princess of Wales (then Duchess of Cambridge - 2022). Paul adjudicated the 2023 Rust-en-Vrede National Portrait Award.

Rust-en-Vrede Gallery + Clay Museum

Operating from the historic Rust-en-Vrede complex in central Durbanville has become a renowned platform emerging artists through its ongoing programme for exhibitions and awards. Amongst others, Rust-en-Vrede hosts a National Portrait Award and is also initiating a National Clay Awards in 2024. A registered non-profit organisation (NPO), the organisation has to pay its own way through art sales and other fundraising initiatives.
